



A Case Report on Treatment of Metastatic Tumor after Testicular Cancer via Faradarmani

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Introduction:

Testicular tumors are the most common solid malignancy in men in the age range of 15 to 34 years old. In 2-3% of patients the tumor is bilateral and in 5 to 10% of patients tumor gradually develops in the other side. The most common sign or symptom of testicular cancer is a painful and firm mass in testicles. Symptoms in advanced stages include cough, gastrointestinal symptoms (mass), back pain (retroperitoneal metastasis), neurologic symptoms (metastasis to brain), lower limb edema (inferior vena cava and iliac thrombosis) and supraclavicular lymphadenopathy.

Treatment of patients with testicular carcinoma is a typical multi-disciplinary approach to solid tumors. By efficient surgery, radiotherapy and combined chemotherapy the survival of low risk patients is up to 99% and high risk patients up to 80% respectively.

Given the occurrence of relapse and side effects of medical treatments (including chemotherapy and radiotherapy) for testicular carcinoma, **Faradarmani** can be regarded as an optimum complementary and alternative treatment.

«**Faradarmani**», as a newly introduced Iranian complementary therapy, which is based on the theory of «**Intelligent Bond**» or «**Common Consciousness of the Parts**» (Figure 1), can be considered in treating various kinds of diseases. The presented case attempts to investigate the effectiveness of **Faradarmani** on treatment of Metastatic Tumor.



Case Presentation:

The patient is a 45 year old man who was diagnosed with seminoma (testicular cancer) and abdominal & pelvic metastases in February 2008.

Abdominal sonography on 17 February 2008 revealed a solid mass with dimensions of 93*84mm in retroperitoneal region which caused a compression on the posterior wall of stomach and increased the distance of aorta and SMA, and because of the compression of left ureter, hydronephrosis was seen on the left side. In abdominal CT scan on 20 February 2008, a massive retroperitoneal space-occupying soft tissue lobulated tumor in the posterior region of pancreas was seen that caused the left kidney to displace and its collecting system to dilate, and by passing through the midline it has increased the distance between the aorta and SMA. The definite presence of cancer and metastasis were documented.

Patient underwent a radical left testicular orchiectomy, and 8 sessions of chemotherapy and 20 sessions of radiotherapy were recommended by his physician to control the cancer. As the patient was a resident of Tabriz, he went to Tehran for chemotherapy where after the evaluation of his medical documents, **the specialists stated that his probable survival rate would be unfortunately 6 months after the chemotherapy due to the advanced stage of the disease.** He started chemotherapy disappointedly and after the first session of chemotherapy he experienced side effects such as severe dyspepsia and pain; consequently, he was discouraged from continuing the therapy.

Upon returning to Tabriz, one of his friends suggested Energy therapy which failed despite its very expensive cost. Shortly after; he was introduced to **Faradarmani**.

Method:

Faradarmani was administered by a trained practitioner (Fara-therapist). During a **Faradarmani** session the patient is asked to close their eyes for at least five minutes and manage to dispel the distracting thoughts, and merely observe, impartially, the feelings and experience encountered during the therapy. The patient was required to do this procedure at least once a day and afterwards the details of his treatment and the subsequent outcome and feelings were discussed once a week with the Fara-therapist. In summary, through **Faradarmani** the patient becomes connected to the Interuniversal Consciousness (the network of awareness and consciousness encompassing the universe – the Divine Intelligence) via Fara-therapist and undergoes the Scanning process; due to the nature of this connection, some information is conveyed and the defective parts are treated (Figure 2).



Results:

After commencing **Faradarmani**, according to the patient's statement he noticed interesting changes after the first session of **Faradarmani**, therefore he undertook **Faradarmani** more seriously. After a while, the patient requested his physician for another scan to monitor his health condition. The physician said it was too soon to do another scan but eventually they proceeded upon his request. In abdominal sonography on 29 April 2008 no solid or cystic tumor was detected and the kidneys and pancreas were also normal. **In the view of the impossibility of such phenomena, all the investigations and tests were repeated and his physician acknowledged this as a miracle.**

In lung Spiral CT Scan in May 2008, no tumor or lymphadenopathy or no tracheal or bronchial system displacement was reported. In abdominal and pelvic spiral CT Scan no space-occupying (mass) lesion was reported, pancreas and vascular structures were normal, and kidneys had normal function. The medical report by specialist physician confirmed that the widespread tumor completely disappeared and the left kidney became smaller in size.

In summary; Metastatic lesions incredibly disappeared in less than two months after initiating **Faradarmani** treatment. The patient has been in good state of health up to this date.

Conclusion:

In the view that in this patient the cancer was diagnosed as advanced and metastatic, based on the classic medical treatments there was not any hope for recovery even after chemotherapy (the specialists stated a poor 6 months prognosis after the chemotherapy); nevertheless through **Faradarmani** method, the entire problem was completely resolved including the kidney problem and according to the patient's statement his life has been revolutionized.

Up to this date no treatment method has been able to totally eradicate such massive tumors without any invasive method in such a short time, in addition, with no side effect and regardless of patient's age or their condition.

Faradarmani can be used to improve testicular cancer and patient's clinical conditions. We strongly recommend that randomized clinical trials be conducted to evaluate the efficacy of **Faradarmani** in treating testicular cancer as a non-invasive, inexpensive treatment, with no side effects that does not interact with any classic conventional medical treatment.

Recommendation:

Due to **Faradarmani**'s high potentials as a complementary and alternative medicine that comes with no side effects, and improves the quality of life and well being, we suggest multi-central research to be carried out in order to achieve more precise statistics on the effectiveness and degree of permanence of this treatment method in treating testicular cancer and possibly on other health conditions.

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An Introduction to Faradarmani & Psymontology:

"**Faradarmani**" and "**Psymontology**" are considered as subdivisions of "**Erfan-e Halgheh (Interuniversal Mysticism)**". The advantage of **Faradarmani**, in comparison with other C.A.M (Complementary and Alternative Medicine) methods, lies in the fact that it is a simple treatment requiring no special place or time. Furthermore, it does not interfere with conventional medical treatments and can in fact proceed concomitantly with conventional medication and treatments. However, the most prominent advantage **Faradarmani** offers is that the diagnosis and treatment processes are error free; hence there will be no side effects. Other advantages include patient satisfaction and comfort.
